Another part of the screening process will include the standards-based report card form. The Lake Washington School District elementary report card uses a 4-point number scale to report student performance based on grade level standard, and the secondary report card uses a 4 point grade point scale. Private school teachers are asked to keep the scale in mind in rating performance.
