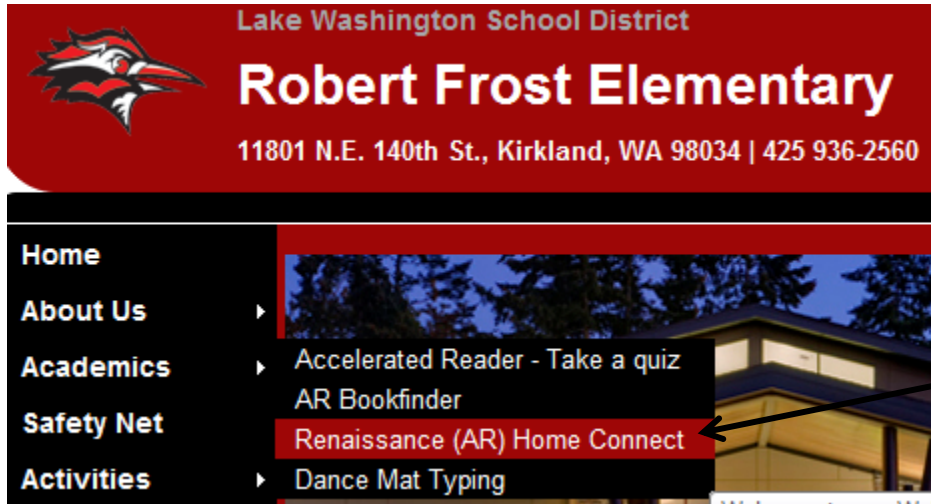


## Setting up Renaissance Home Connect

Renaissance Home Connect is a way for students, parents, and guardians to monitor student progress on Accelerated Reader quizzes from home. Here is a guide on how to set it up.



1. From the main Frost web page, mouse over the Academics link and select Renaissance Home Connect.

2. Fill in your student's username and their password. In most cases, the username is the student's first initial and the first 4 letters of the last name, but check with your student! The password is the first and last initial. For example, for John Doe, the username would be jdoe and the password jd. There are a few students with the same last name and their usernames would be slightly different, so check with your child.
3. After logging in, you will be able to see several aspects of your student's progress with Accelerated Reader Quizzes.

- a. The average percent correct on quizzes
  - b. The student's total points
  - c. Reader certifications and goals
  - d. The last quiz taken is highlighted
  - e. Clicking on "View My Bookshelf" will show pictures of the books quizzes have been taken on
4. In the top right menu after logging in, one can elect to read the information in Spanish, or click on Email Setup to add up to 6 people who will be emailed every time your student takes a quiz.
