What you can expect: In the early 1990's Seattle became world-famous for two things: its coffee and its music scene. If you're dreaming of becoming the next CEO of a world-famous coffee company, that's awesome...I love coffee. But if you're dreaming of being a part of the next world-famous Seattle band, then this focus week is for you! Grab your guitar, keyboards or drumsticks and head to the EMP museum for an intensive, one week training in what it takes to make a successful rock band. As you learn to write songs within the dynamic of a band, you will gain confidence in your performance ability and develop your musical potential. Over the course of the week you will talk about songwriting structure and analyze your favorite songs. You will form a band with some of your fellow focus week attendees, write songs, and jam through them with the guidance of a professional Seattle musician. At the end of the week your band will perform 1-3 songs in the JBL Theater at the EMP.
