### 2. SHOP. SWIPE. EARN.

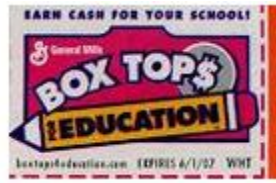
Each participating product that you purchase from your favorite participating retailer will earn 1 point that will be credited to your school's *Labels for Education* account automatically.

***House Keeping*** IF there is a title past due, an email notification will still be sent automatically to both the student and the parent/guardian. Emails will continue to be sent each time the DESTINY tool is used, until the book title is returned. Please be aware sometimes students “share” their student account numbers when checking out a book title. And although your student may not have the overdue book, it is under his/her name, and therefore is his or her responsibility.

Sometimes titles do become lost, are misplaced, or damaged. Fines are placed on the student’s District profile until the fine is paid. Please ask you student top come talk to Mr. Ritchie. If we know what is going on, we can work with your student regarding the book in question.

***Your DESTINY*** Students are able to set up an on-line DESTINY account through our school page! They can **renew** (to avoid those pesky emails!), **hold**, or **request** books from other schools through their DESTINY accounts. Just ask your student to follow these instructions:

1. <http://www.lwsd.org/school/KIJH/Library/Pages/default.aspx> (this is the Kirkland JHS Library home page). Please note – if a window pops up, cancel it). On the HOME PAGE, you can contact Mr. Ritchie or Ms. Wells. Your student has access to creating his/her DESTINY account. Students may also be able to access teacher assignments, and are able to access LWSO approved web sites. You can also find our web page on the LWSO web page.
2. When creating a student DESTINY profile, go to the bottom of the home page and select the “Create your DESTINY account”. Follow the instructions, and voilà! Your student now has his/her own DESTINY profile!

Make sure your student returns your borrowed book to the *correct* Library! It happens! Sometimes, our borrowed books end up being returned to the Kirkland COUNTY Library, and vice versa! ☺ It is easy for us to have the book returned to the county. It is more difficult for the county to return one of our books. So please, be careful. ☺
