

Students in the Lake Washington School District are required to have current immunization information on file.

Starting July 1, 2007, Washington State Law required all children eleven years old and entering 6th grade in September 2009 show proof of the following immunizations:

- **Tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (Tdap)** vaccination if he/she is **11 years old** and it has been **five years** since he/she received a tetanus-containing vaccine, like DTaP or a tetanus-diphtheria (Td) booster.
- **Varicella** (chickenpox) vaccination, approximate date of illness, or results from a blood test that show he/she is immune.

According to Washington State Immunization Law (RCW 28A.210.120), children **will not** be allowed to attend school in September 2009 until you provide information that he/she has received the necessary vaccine(s) or you have signed the exemption on the back of the Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) form for philosophical, religious or medical reasons.
