Dog-Gone Award – This is a Rockwell award to recognize and honor volunteers and/or staff members in their last year of service at Norman Rockwell.

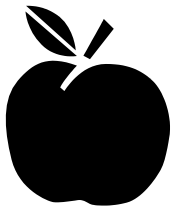


Bow-Wow Award – This is a Rockwell award to recognize volunteers for their outstanding service to the Rockwell students and community.



Golden Acorn Award – Is an award that is offered by the WA State PTA for recognition of a volunteer who has given outstanding service to **all** children in the school community; not just an individual who has donated time to help in his/her child's class or a staff member who is doing a good job. It is to recognize volunteer service "above and beyond" a particular job

description. A contribution in the name of the recipient(s) is made by the honoring PTA to the Washington State PTA Financial Grant Program. From these contributions, WSPTA is able to provide grants to freshman students entering post-secondary education.



Outstanding Educator Award - The Outstanding Educator Award is offered by the Washington State PTA to recognize individuals who go beyond the normal expectations of their jobs to make the learning environment fun, beneficial and challenging. An outstanding educator could be a teacher, assistant, custodian, bus driver, administrator or community member. A

contribution in the name of the recipient(s) is made by the honoring PTA to the Washington State PTA Financial Grant Program. From these contributions, WSPTA is able to provide grants to freshman students entering post-secondary education.
