Library Rules

1. Participate

Checkout

Always bring your books to the library

K-1 may have 1 item checked out at a time for 1 week

2nd grade may have up to 2 items for 2 weeks

3rd—6th grade may have items up to the number of their grade level, (example 4 books for 4th grade), checked out for up to 2 weeks

You may check out books during recesses with a library pass

If you have **any overdue items**, you will not be allowed to check out books
