



Student Camp Equipment List

All students need to pack and bring the required items **permanently marked with student name**. There are no laundry facilities—bring “old” clothes!! **Please do not bring expensive items**. Neither the Lake Washington School District nor the CYO assume any responsibility for lost items.

REQUIRED ITEMS

1 large duffel bag (lined with plastic bag) containing:

- 1 pair long jeans or pants
- 2 pairs of shorts
- 2 t-shirts
- Changes of underwear
- Warm jacket and stocking cap
- Hat or cap for sun
- Rain gear (jacket and pants)
- 3 pairs of socks
- Swimsuit (1-piece or **modest** 2-piece for girls)
- Sweater, fleece, or warm sweatshirt
- Pajamas
- 1 pair tennis shoes
- 1 pair sturdy shoes or boots
- Flashlight or headlamp w/new batteries
- Personal toiletries (toothbrush, deodorant, soap, etc.)
- Towel
- Warm sleeping bag (preferably in stuff sack labeled with name and lined with plastic bag)

1 Daypack (with student at all times) containing:

- Tupperware or plastic container with sealable lid to hold daily lunches
- Lunch for 1st day
- Water bottle marked w/ student's name
- Expedition Journal and pens/pencils in a zip-loc bag
- Sweater or fleece
- Rain jacket
- Sunscreen (SPF 15 or higher)
- Work gloves

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Camera
- Insect repellent (not aerosol)
- Small bottle of hand sanitizer

DO NOT BRING

- Radio; tape or CD players; ipods; cell phones, pagers, or any electronic devices or games (These will be confiscated for the remainder of the school year.)
- Gum or candy
- Matches, fireworks
- Knives
- Expensive watches/jewelry
- Magazines
- Marking Pens

IMPORTANT:

All items must be clearly marked with student's name.
