General Rules

1. The "Works Consulted" page is the final page of your paper.
2. Entries are listed in alphabetical order by the first letter of the entry.
3. Double space the entire page.
4. Indent the second, third, and fourth lines of each entry.

Examples

Book (a. c. e: d, h. k.)

Author. *Book Title*. Place: Publisher, Copyright date. Medium of Publication.

Example:

Woog, Adam. *Sexless Oysters and Self-Tipping Hats*. Seattle: Sasquatch, 1991. Print.

Magazine/Newspaper Article (a. "b." c. h: g. k.)

Author. "Article Title." *Magazine Title*. Date: pages. Medium of Publication.

Example:

Judd, Judy. "New Things." *Newsweek*. 27 June 1998: 59-60. Print.

Interview (a .i.)

Last Name, First Name. Type of interview by whom. Date.

Example:

Kiewit, Peter. Personal Interview by Susan Smith. 2 May 1998.

Encyclopedia Article Online (a. "b." c. d. h. k. i <f>.)

Author. "Article Title." *Book Title*. Publisher. Copyright Date. Medium of Publication. Date of Access <URL>.

Example:

Carter, David, "Inventions." *World Book Student*. World Book, 2009. Web. 29 Oct. 2009

<www.worldbookonline.com>.

Online Database (a. "b." c. h:g. k. j. i <f>.)

Author. "Article/Page Title." *Magazine Title*. Date of Source: Pages. Medium of Publication. *Name of Database*.

Date Accessed <URL>.

Example:

Hassol, Susan. "A Change of Climate." *Issues in Science and Technology*. May 2003: 39-46. Web. *ELibrary*. 18

May 2005 <http:www.proquestk12.com >.

General Website (a. "b." c. h. k. i <f>.)

Author. "Article Title." *Site Title*. Date of Source. Medium of Publication. Date Accessed <URL>.

Example:
