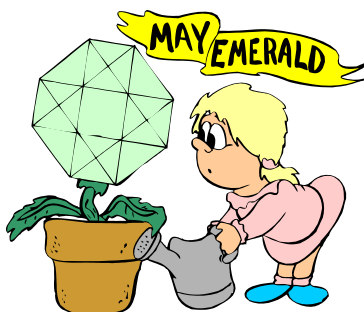
9th Grade Parent Cruise Information Below:

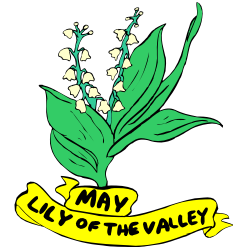


Hello, 9th Grade Parents,

On April 24th, we conducted an assembly and gave the 9th grade students the full details of the 9th grade cruise. Cruise packets were be distributed here at school at the 9th grade assembly during Falcon Time. They were taught the items below as well as the other requirements for attending the cruise. Please fill out the necessary forms COMPLETELY and have your child return these forms to Finn Hill by the date listed on the packet. Below, I have highlighted a few of the facts that students must follow in order to attend the cruise on June 9th:

*All students must follow the Coast Guard rules, as well as the Finn Hill dress code, in order to attend the cruise, i.e. no spaghetti strap tops, no bare midriffs, no sagging pants. We suggest that students wear casual, tropical, colorful dress. This year's theme is Black and White. Students may dress as they desire as long as it is school appropriate and safe for the cruise ship. Those who do not follow

the Finn Hill dress code as stated in our planner will not be allowed to board the bus, and no refunds will be given.

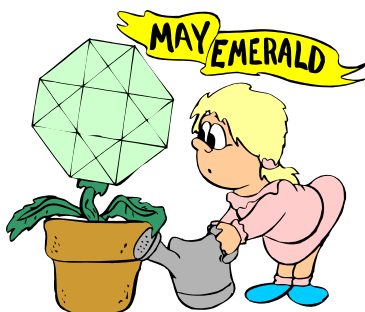

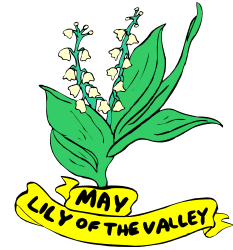
*Students who receive serious discipline consequences during 4th quarter that result in out-of-school suspension will not be allowed to attend the cruise. Please speak to your young adult and emphasize the importance of maturity, good academics and behavior as part of the process of moving up the grade ladder to high school and life.

*Students may not have in their possession, or be under the influence of, any drug, alcohol, and tobacco or prescription medication. If your child needs medication, please let the cruise directors know, and we will make accommodations as needed. Any student who fails to comply with the "ZERO" Tolerance policy of the Lake Washington School District will be disciplined accordingly, and police will be contacted. Discipline will carry over to high school. Thank you for your cooperation!

*Please have all paperwork and payments in by the deadlines listed on the packet, as these numbers will determine our preparation for this fun event. Scholarships are available. Turn in days are every Thursday during both lunches on the cafeteria stage between now and June 2nd.

*Students may not bring visitors to the cruise, neither minors nor adults. Finn Hill is a closed campus, and this event is for 9th grade students of Finn Hill only. Teacher and staff chaperones will be organized and signed up by your cruise directors.
