Emergency Preparedness and Safety \$600 – Funds are provided to purchase emergency supplies such as flashlights, batteries, sanitary supplies, etc., to be kept at school for use by students and staff in case of an emergency.

Student Calendar Planners \$3500 – Used daily by students to make note of assignment due dates.

Falcons Care \$1000 – Financial assistance provided to students for class fees and other expenses deemed necessary by school administration.

Library Supplies \$1000 – Books and other items provided, above and beyond what is provided by the school district.

Student Directory \$300 – This is a closed directory, to be used solely for the personal use of Finn Hill students and parents. Use district “Directory Information Withhold Form” to opt out of this directory.

Falcon Field Day \$1300 – DJ, big inflatables and other fun brought to you by PTSA!

Staff Appreciation \$400 – Treats, snacks and goodies for a week-long celebration of our wonderful staff.

PTSA Administrative Costs \$1500 – Category includes insurance, paper and office supplies, local, regional and state PTA conferences/workshops.

Falcon Spirit Awards \$450 – Every quarter, students are recognized by staff for good citizenship. Ice cream sundaes are provided to winners.

PTSA Awards \$200 – Outstanding staff and volunteers are recognized for their contributions to the Finn Hill community, which includes awards from Washington State PTA.

College Scholarships \$1700 – Finn Hill alumni are awarded college scholarships, and a contribution is made to the LWPTSA Council staff and high school senior scholarship committee.

Levy Support \$50 – An annual donation is made to the Lake Washington Citizen’s Levy Committee, which is responsible for campaigning for levies and bonds in the Lake Washington School District.

Student Social Events \$500 – Dances for students.

Hospitality \$250 – Snacks served at PTSA meetings and events.

State Testing Treats \$400 – Studies show test performance is best when students receive snack breaks during testing. PTSA will donate all testing snacks this year, with no further need for donation of items from families.

Reader Board Fund \$1000 – Annual donation is made toward new school reader board fund.

Reflections \$100 – Participate in National PTA Arts Contest.
