### 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> GRADE SPECIFIC ITEMS

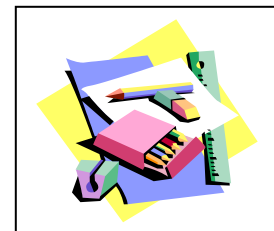
- 2 Composition Books, Non-spiral bound, minimum 80 pages for Science and Math
- 1 Non-spiral bound 8.5x11" notebook for LA/SS classes
- Graph paper for Science and Math (can be composition book or separate pages)
- 1 Protractor
- 1 Scientific calculator - ask teacher which model number
- 1 Metric ruler

### 9<sup>th</sup> GRADE SPECIFIC ITEMS

- 1 Compass
- 1 Scientific calculator - ask teacher which model number
- 1 Composition book with graph paper
- 2 Spiral notebooks
- 3 writing folders with pockets
- 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " 3-ring binder for Arts Alive

- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 Pencil Pouch including:
  - 2 black sharpies-fine point
  - 1 set colored markers
  - 1 set colored pencils
  - 4 ball point pens (2-black; 2-blue)
  - 5 red ball point pens (for grading)
  - 6 pencils with erasers
  - 1 highlighter pen (any color)
  - 4 glue sticks
