Leadership Class Expectations

It is expected, as a member of the Leadership class, that you will conform to the basic expectations of a leader and a role model. Please carefully read the following and sign below. This form will be kept on file.

1. Student leaders are expected to demonstrate citizenship and conduct that is **beyond criticism** at all times. Students involved in deviant acts such as stealing, vandalism, or improper behavior towards others may be removed from office and Leadership class.
2. Use of tobacco, alcohol, and other illegal drugs at any time during the 2005-2006 school year **will** result in the immediate removal from office and Leadership class. Being in the presence of minors who are using alcohol, tobacco, or other illegal drugs may also result in removal from office and Leadership.
3. A 2.5 grade point average is required to serve as a student body officer or to be in Leadership. If, at any time, you fall below that average or are failing one or more classes, you will be placed on probation, and together we will develop a plan of improvement. You will not be allowed to go on any field trips or help with any big projects until your grade improves.
4. Suspension from Inglewood Junior High, for any reason, will result in removal from office and Leadership. Continual detentions from teachers and/or referrals to the Assistant Principal will also result in removal.
5. All Leadership students are required to be members of the Associated Student Body; you must have a current ASB card.
6. Room cleanup is very important. You are responsible for putting things back where they belong. **Failure to clean up will result in a lower weekly grade.**
7. Please **wear your button at all times**, so people can identify you as a Leadership student.
8. Please be on time to class. Each tardy will lower your weekly grade. Your third unexcused tardy will result in a 30 minute detention, as well as a loss of "out of room" privileges for a week.
9. You need to be in the room when you are not working on a class project.
10. You will be proactive in seeking out work when finished with assigned "jobs." Do not sit around idly until you are noticed.

Remember, you are a leadership student at all times, not just during 4<sup>th</sup> period. Please be aware that your words and actions are a not only a reflection of you, but of this class as well.
