

I-Search/Annotated Bibliography

The research component of your Culminating Project is to read several related books related to your Culminating Project in some way, and show evidence of this in an annotated bibliography.

The real work of doing an annotated bibliography is to read the books. The document you produce serves as evidence you did this.

For each of your resources (pick 4-5, with a max of 2 websites), do the following:

- 1. Start with a citation in MLA format. (See library opening page.)**
- 2. Write three intelligent paragraphs reflecting different sections of the book.**
- 3. Make sure these are flawlessly edited.**

Write one or two paragraphs in which you compare ideas or styles from source to source.

Your bibliography is required to thoroughly illustrate your reading and to show the connections you've made among several books. You should also include an argument for the validity of your resources. (this source is reliable because...)

Use the attached sample as your *guide*. It is not complete.

Your bibliography should show this degree of specificity.

Minimum length: Four pages

Type in 12 pt font,

Times New Roman,

Double spaced

1" margins
