The final display board must be complete in order to be accepted for community night. ALL of the elements below must be clearly evident. Your advisor will put a check symbol ✓ in the boxes next to each item that is visible on your display.

1) Project Description must include...

	Where and when you worked
	Whom you worked with (partner, supervisors, etc.)
	What you did at each stage (what you did while working)

2) Graphic images must include...

	Examples of how you worked (must show students working) & what you did for your project
	<i>If applicable</i> , evidence of your final product
	Borders &/or tabs should accent & highlight all photographs

3) Issue Information must include...

	Current info/data defining the nature of the issue that includes THREE specific facts
	Complete source citation information in MLA format for the THREE different sources you used

4) Self-evaluation must include...

	Reflections about the experience you had while working
	Reflections about what you learned about yourself while working
	Advice for a student who pursues a similar project next year

5) Layout must include...

	Large, visible headings with your full name and project title that is obvious at first glance
	Clear, typed captions for each picture to guide the viewer
	No glaring proofreading errors: spelling, punctuation, and capitalization
	Display has a clean, professional appearance

6) Display evaluation...

	Revision required (DUE by: 5/19)
	No credit

7) Bonus points for originality, outstanding commitment, and for an exceptionally thoughtful, creative display.
