RE: **SPORTS PARTICIPATION FEE**

Due to the rising costs associated with the support of the district's athletics program, the Lake Washington School District Board of Directors approved a participation fee for the 2009-10 school year. Fees will be collected on a per sport basis with both individual and family caps. The family caps will apply for brothers/sisters who attend the *same* school.

Fees must be paid *separately* for each season and prior to first practice; payments will be noted on the eligibility list approved by the school ASB/Activities Secretary. Refunds will be provided at 100% if a student quits due to illness, injury or moves prior to 1st competition. Students may not participate in practices until the Sports Participation Fees are paid. Parents of students who anticipate financial hardships should contact the Kamiakin Jr. High Athletic Director, Neil Kells, or Suzi Bajorek.

Junior High Athletics Season Timeline:

9th graders participating at the senior high level should contact the school directly for start dates, as they differ (3 season) from the junior high 4 season format

Season 1: August - October

Girls: Fastpitch Softball, Badminton, Soccer (HS), Cross Country (HS), Swimming./ Diving (HS)

Boys: Basketball (7), Football (8 & 9), Tennis, Golf (HS) Cross Country (HS)

Season 2: November - January

Girls: Basketball, Gymnastics (HS)

Boys: Basketball (8-9), Swimming/ Diving (HS)

Season 3: January - March

Boys: Wrestling

Girls: Volleyball (8 & 9)

Season 4: April - June

Boys: Baseball, Track, Soccer (HS)

Girls: Track, Tennis, Volleyball (7), Golf (HS)

The following participation fees apply for the 2009-10 school year:

Please note: Team managers will not be required to pay fees.

Junior High School (applies to 7-9th graders participating at Kamiakin)

\$105 per sport with an individual cap of \$210

Siblings at the same school are capped at \$105

What this means:

Student A has no siblings at the school and plays two sports. Fee: \$210

Student B has no siblings at the school and plays three sports. Fee: \$210

Students C and D are siblings at the same school. Student C plays three sports and Student D plays two sports. Fee: \$315

Senior High School (applies to 9th graders participating at Juanita High School)

\$275 per sport with an individual cap of \$550

Siblings at the same school pay \$275 with a cap of \$275

What this means:

Student A has no siblings at the school and plays two sports. Fee: \$550

Student B has no siblings at the school and plays three sports. Fee: \$550

Students C and D are siblings at the same school. Student C plays three sports and Student D plays two sports. Fee: \$1000
