Please use the community service board in the counseling office to promote opportunities you are aware of or to seek a new service idea. Lastly, you could complete your community service at school in which case you would need a staff member to act as your sponsor. You need to have your service supervisor sign the attached form(s).

The first semester form needs to be completed and returned by January 21st to Ms. Russell in room 223, the second semester form needs to be completed and returned by May 13th (before our final meeting).
