## **Lakeview Elementary PTSA General Meeting**

### **Board**

The Board for this year was introduced.

### **Approval of Minutes and Standing Rules**

The minutes and Standing Rules were distributed from the June meeting and approved as printed.

### **Principal's Report**

Principal Shawna Rothaus was unable to attend and sent a written letter that was distributed. Presented to the PTSA by Shawna, Wendy Macomber moved that we adopt the Lakeview Mission Statement. The statement was amended to read:

"The Lakeview PTSA fosters the learning environment to enable each student to reach his *or* her academic and social goals."

This was seconded by Karen Tipp. All present voted in favor.

### **Budget**

The budget for the current school year was distributed. In tonight's meeting, Marypat Meuli represented treasurer Mary Pund by walking through the individual "buckets" of areas on the budget for those present. All present voted in favor of approving the budget as presented for the 2010/2011 year. President Wendy Macomber solicited the group for a "non-board member" person who would volunteer for the Ways and Means committee for this coming year. She had some interest for the position.

### **Committee Reports**

- Fundraising- Karen Tipp reviewed our four areas of fundraising for the year. We have received \$12,000 of our \$20,000 goal so far. The Metropolitan Market Scrip program will take 10% of a market gift card as a donation to the PTSA. Sally Foster Gift Wrap catalogs will be sent home at the end of October. The Silent Auction during our annual Lakeview Carnival will contain mostly teacher experiences and some entertainment tickets as opposed to the gift baskets that were done by each classroom parent last year.
- Academic Support- Brenda Kern shared that Lakeview teachers have until October 15<sup>th</sup> to submit applications for \$2,100 in Teacher grants.
- Special Events- Kristen Estes reviewed the events planned for the coming year with emphasis on the upcoming Walk to School Week and Family Dance night on October 29<sup>th</sup>.
- Membership- Rainer Huber is enthusiastic that we have over 400 members of the PTSA for this year. Volunteers are coordinated by Sarah Stone.
- Communications- Jenny Carlson will be e-mailing the school publication "Leopard Tales" every other week which is a change from last year. The newsletter is archived and previous issues can be viewed through the web site.

- Before/After School Enrichment- Karee Oliver is hoping to meet the desires of the Lakeview community with regard to afterschool classes and is open to new ideas. The afterschool ski bus program was explained.
- School Services- Carol Buckingham has a volunteer in place for the Adopt a Stop program and needs an interested volunteer for the Emergency Prep position at Lakeview.

### **Levy & School Board Update**

Chris Carlson described the Levy that will be presented to the voters in February to accommodate the growing numbers of students entering our district each year (around 500/year) and our limited facilities. The growth in our district is troublesome for future students and without money needed the district will be forced to make very difficult choices as to how to educate the kids.
