THE NORTHWEST ART COMMITTEE PURPOSE OF THE NORTHWEST ART PROJECT

This project commenced under the guidance of the Seattle Public Schools with the goal of acquainting school children with the rich artistic production of their own area giving them the opportunity to see and discuss it in an informal small classroom setting, with trained volunteer docents.

The Collection is financed, owned and cared for by the Junior League of Seattle, and is transported by the school system served.

Purpose

- To help children in their appreciation and understanding of regional contemporary art, thereby developing their capacity to view all visual art and add further cultural background to their studies.
- To provide an intimate and personal art experience through the informal discussion about works shown, the artists, their techniques and varied approaches to seeing art.
- To stimulate sensitivity to the visual as well as the tactile. To stimulate the child's own reaction to use their imaginative powers. To stimulate the child to create for him/herself.
- To support and further the artistic production of the Northwest.
