Program operates **6 Wednesdays** (1/13, 1/20, 1/27, 2/03, 2/10 & 2/24). If weather forces a postponement we automatically extend until all weeks are completed. We do not operate Presidents' Holiday week (2/13 - 2/19).

Bus loads at LWHS Parking Lot at 12:30 PM & returns about **8:00 PM**, road conditions permitting. We do reserve the right for our buses to make up to one stop along the route to accommodate other bus riders who may not have other transportation options to the mountains. Parents must pick up students as soon as bus arrives. **Daily "Bus Only" tickets** are sold at bus for \$30 (space available & signed participation form required).

Weekly **Beginner to Expert** lessons are **1.5 hrs** long. Our experienced, friendly staff will help you improve. Classes have friends of similar age & ability. Beginner classes are at 2:30 PM, all others are at 4:30 PM. As skills increase students may be moved to another class to optimize their learning & progress.



Some classes have an **Instructor & Assistant**, so you learn faster. *If you are at least 16 years old (to instruct) or 13 years old (to assist) and you want to learn more about joining our staff go to: www.yss-info.org and download our employment flier.*

Participation Agreement & Liability Release

I/we recognize that snow sports activities are hazardous and could result in serious injury or death. I/we understand helmets are recommended, that providing/wearing an appropriate helmet is up to the participant and that exposure to injury or death may increase if I/we do NOT wear a helmet. I/we understand and agree that I/we may be riding the chairlifts with a student, instructor, a member of the public or I/we may be riding the lift alone. I/we have voluntarily made a choice to participate in this activity and accept the inherent risks. I/we accept my/our responsibility to be informed, behave prudently, and to read and abide by the Responsibility Code and all other posted behavior notices in these sports and in the ski area/mountain environment. I/we agree to **Release, Forever Discharge, Defend, Indemnify, and Hold Harmless** Youth Sports Services, Inc., JMS, Inc., LW School District or any of its schools, PTSA's/PTA's of any of their volunteers, the bus transportation company, Boyne USA, Inc., Ski Lifts, Inc., DBA The Summit at Snoqualmie, it's parent, subsidiary and affiliated companies, the U.S. Government-U.S. Forest Service, its/their respective agents, officers, directors, owners, contractors, volunteers, employees, insurers, and real and personal property owners, as well as equipment manufacturers and distributors, and all event sponsors (hereinafter "Releasees") of and from any and all liability, claims, liens, demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, cost, damage or injury, including death, of any person or damage to property of any kind related in any way to the Program's operations or the errors or omissions of the Program, its agents, subcontractors, volunteers, or any other person directly or indirectly employed by them, or any of them, while engaged in any activity associated with this Agreement, whether contractually or otherwise.

This Release is binding as to any other persons, including family members, heirs and executors. If I am signing on behalf of a minor, I guarantee I am duly authorized to do so. I recognize that I may not release any claims the minor may have. However, I accept full responsibility for all medical expenses, damages and/or claims incurred as a result of the minor's participation in or travels to and from the program.

Lessons and busing are transferable for a \$25 service charge, but are NOT REFUNDABLE since financial commitments for insurance, staffing, administration, operations, and busing is made prior to the start of the program based upon the number of enrollees. However, if the program is not completed by April 9th, refund checks will be issued less the number of trips operated. An administration fee of \$50 is charged by Youth Sports Services, Inc., or JMS, Inc. if you are issued a refund. Please note that postponing one or two times a season and extending the program is typical due to weather or road conditions. Also, if there is less than three registered students for any class, we reserve the right to cancel the class or reduce the lesson time.

Participants will be expelled from this program without refund for being willfully disobedient; possession, use or sale of tobacco, alcohol, or controlled substances; vulgarity; discussing sexual topics; harassment; stealing; gambling; fighting; leaving the ski area; or for using non-approved transportation; or for returning to the bus past the set departure time. Additionally, if the participant's late arrival causes the bus to return late, the **participant and/or parents will reimburse the program for all additional costs incurred** (this is a minimum of \$100 per hour, per bus delayed).

These activities are not sponsored nor endorsed by LW School District or any of its schools. The district assumes no responsibility for the conduct during or safety of the activities and shall be held harmless from any cause of action, claim, or petition filed in any court or administrative tribunal arising out of the distribution of these materials including attorney's fees, judgments or awards.
