Looking forward to our new year at Northstar it is time to begin our commitment to the school. Northstar is founded upon parent commitment of time and money. Each family is asked to contribute a minimum of \$200 and 30 hours per year. The Northstar educational program is unique and provides additional educational experiences beyond the regular curriculum offered at the traditional junior high schools. The programs can only be offered with the time and money commitment of the parents.

We recognize that it can be difficult for some families to contribute the \$200 at the beginning of the year. There are payment plans available to assist with spreading the payments out over the course of the year if needed.

The good news is that the contributions are recognized as charitable 501c3 donations by the IRS. This may be beneficial for some families at tax time. Be sure to consult your tax preparer for more information. It also means that many companies which match contributions such as Microsoft and Boeing will match parent donations. Some of our parents choose to make their contribution by payroll deduction.
