

## NAC Meeting

June 12, 2007

Meeting called to order at 7:04

Minutes for May were not published yet.

**Orchids:** To the flower box fairies. New flower boxes were delivered during the clip and clean. To Bob from Lia, and to Ski for his work as President. To parents who helped at talent show. To Bob and his class for the Medieval fair.

**Teacher's Report:** Met with Nel Ballard-Jones to discuss Northstar's future. The high school is having to let some staff go to meet budget requirements tied to student enrollment levels. They asked the district for part of the Jr High budgets for the kids that are sent from the jr highs. This would put a crunch on our budget too. So, there will likely not be any budget changes but high school classes will only be available on a "space available" basis to junior high students.

**Treasurer's Report:** Our financial situation is currently healthy. We still have some expenses to be posted. Some of the classroom supplies may be over budget. Skip will address those issues. If you have any questions regarding NAC finances, call Skip.

**Landscape Committee:** We had our last clip and clean on June 9<sup>th</sup>. Fairly low turnout but got a lot done. The memorial garden was weeded. New planter boxes were installed. The plants will not be put in until the fall because we don't have a watering system.

**Conference Week:** Kids are signing up for the offered classes. If you have volunteered but haven't heard from Lia yet, email her to find out what you need to do. The last hour of conference week on Thursday will be a year book signing party with pizza. A past parent has offered a scholarship for a couple of yearbooks for kids who cannot afford one.

**Field Trip:** We did not get enough parents to go to Wild Waves and we lost our booking to Funtasia. The kids will be going to Bullwinkle's Family Fun Center.

**New Business:** Should be hearing from support groups for conferences. Conferences are just for kids moving on to a new school or those who may be struggling. You may request a conference if you feel the need.

The 9<sup>th</sup> grade dinner planning is going well.

New officers for next year were voted in: Richard Harrison for President, Cassie Heaton for Secretary, Skip Felts for Treasurer.

The welcome back picnic on August 30<sup>th</sup> was discussed. Looked at ideas for activities. A 7<sup>th</sup> grade orientation an hour before hand was very helpful last year.

The 9<sup>th</sup> grade girls have presented a proposal to repaint the student lounge. They want to repaint the ceiling white, the lockers blue and sponge paint silver stars on the lockers. We would need metal paint which adds to the cost and they want to do it this weekend. Was suggested that we look for donated paints and postpone by one week. Was moved and passed that we donate \$300 from the NAC budget.

**School Modernization:** Current plan is to have two buildings and each building would be in two halves. The buildings are multi-story. The hope is that Northstar would have the ground floor of one half of one of the buildings. We don't know if we would have a courtyard or some sort of outdoor space. There should be some firmer plans by the end of the summer. We should find out some time next year where Northstar will be housed during construction since the new building will be placed where Northstar currently is situated.
