Important Dates for
soon-to-be 6th and 7th Graders



January 2012: RHJH Counselors visit all feeder elementary schools to give registration information and explain elective options. Students will receive course catalog information and elective request form at this time.

February 3rd: Completed elective request forms for all elementary students are due back to 5th or 6th grade teachers at your current elementary, the Rose Hill Counseling Office or can be turned in on January 26th at the 5th/6th grade parent night.

1st Week of May: *Optional* Algebra Aptitude Test for current 6th graders advanced placement in 7th grade math will be administered. Specific dates will be given closer to testing time. Please note: **All current 5th graders will be enrolled in CMP 6 for their 6th grade math placement.**

Early June: Rose Hill Student Mentors will visit each elementary school to meet with 5th and 6th grade students in small groups to provide a special welcome to all new Royals. These mentors will be matched up with the students throughout their first year at RHMS.

August 24th 9:30-11:00 am: Orientation for new 7th graders

August 24th 12:00-1:30 pm: Orientation for new 6th graders

Families will have the opportunity to take care of all their back to school business at one time! Get school photo taken, purchase ASB card and yearbook, turn in completed school forms and verify contact information, turn in athletics clearance form, pay school fees, and order RHJH apparel. Students will be meeting in their Mentor Group to get more acquainted with one another and RHMS. Parents will meet in the auditorium for an important information session.

September 4th: First Day of School! Specific details for the first day will be communicated closer to the start of school. Students will get their schedule, meet their teachers and special welcoming activities will take place.
