# What is a Graduation Portfolio?

---

- A Graduation Portfolio is a collection of evidence demonstrating that a student has the skills and knowledge expected of a graduate from RHS and the LWSD.
- Artifacts in the portfolio will include teacher assigned items from each class, along with 2 student-choice items per year. The student-choice items can be examples of their work from in and out of school.
- An artifact is evidence of what you learned and how you have grown as a student. Evidence can be a written piece of work, an audio recording, a video, or a series of pictures.
