## Bump Game

Number of players = 2

### Materials Needed:

Bump Game Card

1 pair of dice

10 colored counters for each player (unifix cubes work great)

### Object:

The goal of the game is to get rid of your 10 colored counters before your opponent.

### How to Play:

1. Choose a game board at your level.
2. One player rolls the dice and finds the sum of the two dice and then **subtracts** the additional amount stated on the game board.
3. The player then places a colored counter on that number.
4. The next player rolls the dice and finds the sum of the two dice and then adds the additional amount stated on the game board. If the number is open the player places their colored counter on that number and the next player takes his/her turn.
5. If the opponent has one counter on that number the player is able to "bump" the opponent's piece.
6. If the opponent has two or more counters on that number they own that number and cannot be bumped.
7. The game is over when one player is able to play all ten of their game pieces.

## Bump Game
