*The **Quest Elementary Program for Highly Capable Students** (Grades 1-6) will be accepting applications for the 2009-2010 school year from November 3, 2008, through 4:00 PM December 3, 2008. This program offers two options for students who demonstrate superior ability, who exceed grade level standards in literacy and math, and who exhibit exceptional creativity in the classroom. Students who qualify for the Full Time program are enrolled in an accelerated, self-contained classroom for the full day, five days a week. Students in the Enrichment Pull Out program attend their home school four days a week and a pullout enrichment classroom one day a week.
