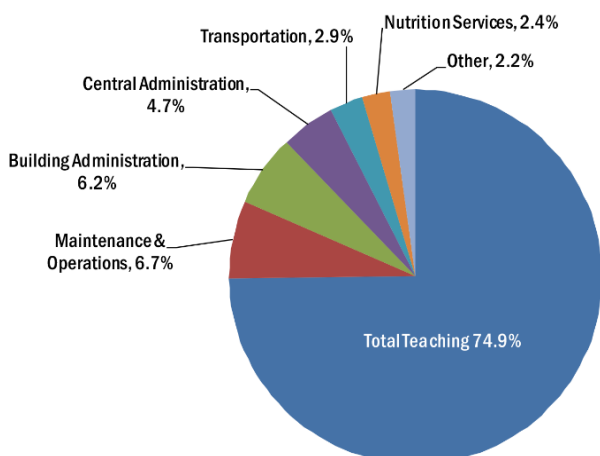
School Description

2015-16 School Goals

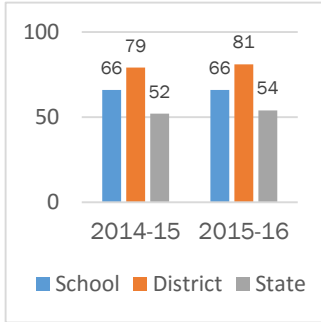
The Mark Twain staff is committed to continued student growth. Collaborative conversations among staff members have helped teams reflect on learning standards and student needs.

- Grades K-2 Reading: 79% of students at standard on the end of year DIBELS
- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts: 73% at standard
- Grades 3-5 Math: 76% at standard
- Grade 5 Science: 80% at standard
- Achievement gap: 28% of students receiving English Language Learner services will move to a level 4 by the end of the year
- School Effectiveness: Increase to 60% the percentage of staff who agree with this statement: "Staff trusts one another." Increase agreement to 40% with the statement "The staff feels free to express their ideas and opinions with one another."
- Discipline: Reduce office referrals by 10%

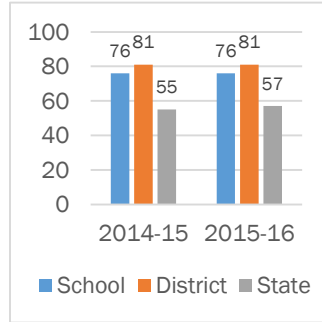

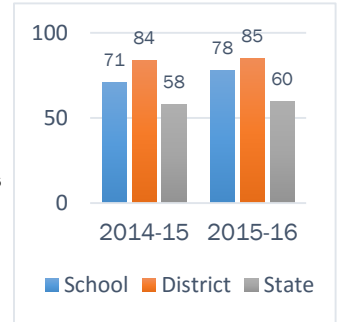
3rd Grade English Language Arts



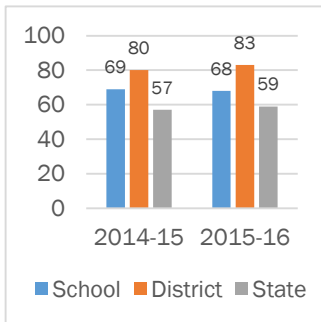
4th Grade English Language Arts



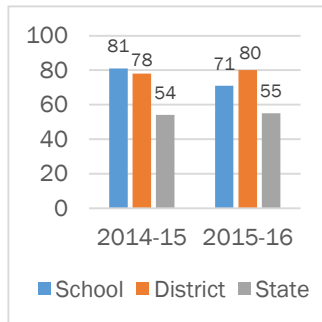
5th Grade English Language Arts



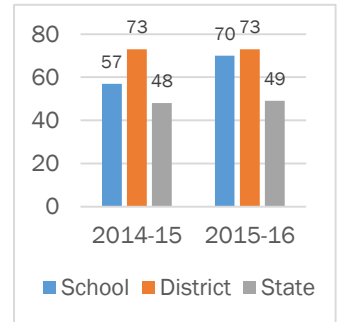
3rd Grade Math



4th Grade Math

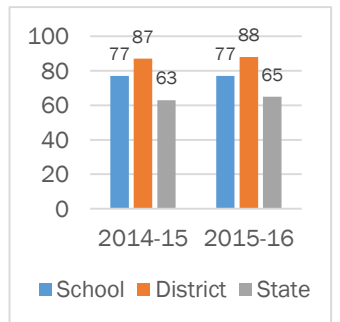


5th Grade Math



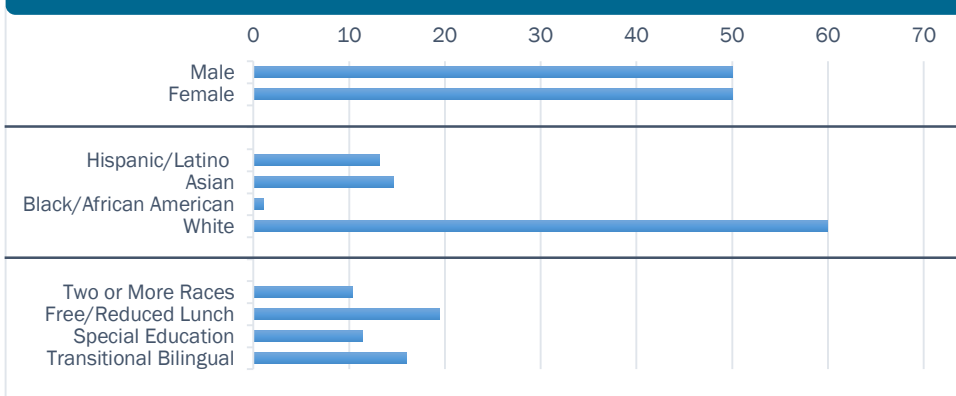
