

Appendix G - Class of 2016 & Beyond Request for Alternatives to World Language Courses

A student may elect to pursue credit in areas other than World Language if all of the following requirements are met:

- a) The student’s choice is based on a career-oriented course of study identified in the student’s High school and Beyond Plan;
- b) The student’s parent/guardian agree that credit in other areas is more appropriate than World Language because it better serves the student’s career goals;
- c) A meeting must be held with the student, parent/guardian, and high school representative to discuss and sign a form acknowledging they understand the World Language requirement is a college-entrance requirement and that they believe that other alternate course selections are more appropriate given the student’s education and career goals;
