## Historical Enrollment Growth

- The district had $\mathbf{1 2}$ straight years of enrollment increases from 2007 to 2019.
- 2020 was the first enrollment decline in 13 years.
- From 2007 to 2020 the district's enrollment grew by an average of 545 students per year
- This is the size of an elementary school each year
