










Elementary School Additions Kirkland Area








Program Cost Update

OSPI approved State Construction Assistance Funds (SCAP) for Lake Washington High School – **\$5.0 million**

- Classroom addition \$3.3 million
- Core expansion \$1.7 million
- Funds are received at end of project
- Funds will be added to 2019 Capital Levy program contingency







Infrastructure - SY2019/2020
