

Functions of Behavior

- Every behavior is a form of communication
- Identify the FUNCTION or the reason/purpose/intention of that behavior
- There are 2 general functions of behavior

Access to:

-Attention -Preferred Activity or item -Preferred sensory experience

Escape from:

-Attention -Non-preferred Activity or item -uncomfortable or painful sensory experience




Daily Learning Activities
