
2021-22 School Goals

Staff members analyzed data and identified areas of focus to increase student performance. Actions steps with specific instructional strategies were articulated for each goal.


- Grades K-5 English Language Arts: 85% at standard

- Opportunity/Achievement Gap: 66% of students identifying as Latino will meet or exceed standard




Where does the money go?
