<u>All 5th grade students</u> are eligible to enroll in elementary band this year! Below I have listed the basics that will help you to plan ahead. Being in band is a fantastic experience that begins in elementary school and continues through middle school, high school, and into adulthood. In addition to learning to play an instrument, your kids will develop many close friendships, and learn to work as a team. Band kids are consistently among the highest academic achievers in school and, as college applicants, they will have an advantage because colleges value the high level of commitment that being in band demonstrates. We would love to have all your kids participate in this exciting, rewarding experience!

Beginning Band Orientation Night

Book

Accent on Achievement Book 1. Make sure to get the book for your instrument! This can be found in the top right corner of the book.

Materials

Most students rent band instruments from a local music store such as Kennelly Keys Music, Music & Arts, Metropolitan Music, etc. Rent-to-own plans are great! We recommend calling ahead to check availability and pick up options.

Each student will need an instrument, the required accessories, Accent on Achievement book (for their instrument), and a folder for music and a pencil. We recommend purchasing a care kit. Most students also purchase a music stand (any type).

The accessories include:

- Flute: cleaning rod, and a soft cloth for cleaning (preferably silk)
- Clarinet: cork grease, a drop through style cleaning cloth, and a minimum of five #2 clarinet reeds.
- Trumpet: valve oil, tuning slide grease, soft cleaning cloth.
- Trombone: slide oil, tuning slide grease, soft cleaning cloth
- 3/4 Baritone: valve oil, tuning slide grease, soft cleaning cloth.
