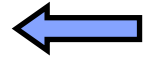

### ◆ **PSAT/NMSQT Scheduled for January**

The PSAT/NMSQT is typically offered each October. The PSAT/NMSQT is the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test. The purpose of the PSAT is to familiarize students with the kinds of questions, style of directions, and physical environment of an SAT exam, and provides students with a projected SAT score range, personalized feedback, and a study plan. 11<sup>th</sup> grade students who take the PSAT/NMSQT are also automatically screened for the [National Merit Scholarship Program](#); an academic competition for recognition and scholarships.

The College Board is now offering a January test administration due to the number of districts across the country in a remote learning environment. The Lake Washington School District plans to offer the PSAT/NMSQT on Tuesday, January 26, 2021. The January administration of the PSAT/NMSQT provides the same experience and opportunity to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program as the October administration. Signups will occur later in the fall and priority will be given to current 11<sup>th</sup> graders. Conditions will continue to be re-evaluated as we get closer to the January test.

**From our Librarian:** The Juanita HS Library has just received permission to have contactless book checkout from the library. We are figuring out our procedures, but we know that JHS students will be able to check out up to 5 books at a time, and then come in during our contactless pickup hours (TBD) to pick up a bag full of books they have requested. Checkout will be done in their name, then the books will be placed in paper bags and left to sit for 3 days. When the pickup hours come, they will be outside, on a table with the student’s name on it, to be grabbed straight from a car. If books are returned, there will be a rolling garbage can there to take in returns, which will be quarantined for 3 days before they are checked in. Under these procedures, we feel like we can confidently check out books to students. When we are ready to go, we will send out announcements about how to check out books through several channels, so that students are informed and ready. ### World Language Testing

Due to remote learning, safety and social distancing protocols, and unique transportation needs of families and students, LWSD is offering more flexible testing windows this year for World Language Testing. Testing will be conducted in person in a small group setting following strict safety and social distancing procedures. We may need to reduce our capacity to test students in order to keep everyone safe and will prioritize current 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders who need credit to graduate first.

We are using a rolling registration this year and students can register now for any of the following testing windows:

- **Wednesdays in November at Juanita High School** (Registration closes October 31, 2020)
- **Wednesdays in January at Eastlake High School** (Registration closes December 31, 2020)
- **Wednesdays in February at Redmond High School** (Registration closes January 31, 2021)
- **Wednesdays in March at Lake Washington High School** (Registration closes February 28, 2021)
- **Any Wednesday at the LWSD Resource Center** (Registration closes March 31, 2021)
