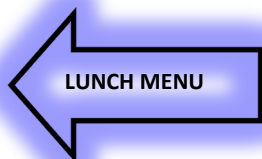

- **FAFSA Help** – Students are welcome to come by the CCC for help completing the FAFSA.

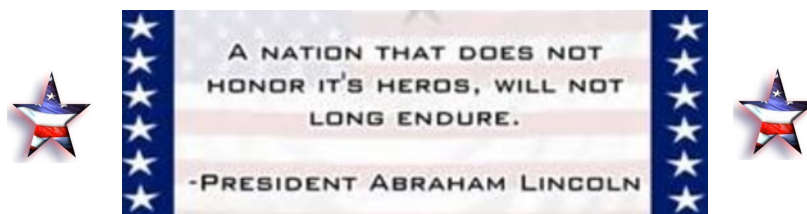
Counseling:
