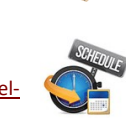

## After School Safety:

In order to ensure the safety of all our students and staff on campus we have some basic expectations and procedures for everyone to be aware of.

- The commons closes after school. Students getting snacks and/or beverages have until 2:50 before they need to leave.
- We lock all the exterior doors to the old building at 3:00.
- Access to the fieldhouse is limited to student athletes who are under the supervision of their coaches, or other student groups who have an advisor there to support them in decorating, planning for assemblies,

## COLLEGE & CAREER CENTER and COUNSELING:

- **Need help applying for Financial Aid for college?** Cascadia College (just a short drive from JHS) will host two drop-in sessions for the 2018-19 financial aid season - Saturday, November 17 & Saturday, January 26 from 10:00a-12:00p . Drop-in sessions are open to high school seniors who would like assistance with the FAFSA or WAFSA application. You do not need to sign up to attend the drop-in session. This is a **free** program that helps students and families complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Washington Application for State Financial Aid (WASFA). You do NOT have to be planning to attend Cascadia to attend this event – it is open to students who plan to go to any college/university.
- **Job and Volunteer Fair**-Thursday, November 29<sup>th</sup>. Visit our Job and Volunteer Fair during Homeroom on November 29<sup>th</sup> from 10:35-11:35 in the Library. Multiple job and volunteer opportunities for students to explore. This event will be a great chance to engage with your local community, build job skills and gain experience.
- **Military visits in the CCC:** We begin military visits this week with two special guests: The **U. S. Air Force** will visit the CCC on Monday, 11/19 at 8:45 and anyone interested in the **U. S. Naval Academy** will be interested to find that former JHS graduate Hayden Anderson will be on hand on Tuesday the 20<sup>th</sup> during 6<sup>th</sup> period.
