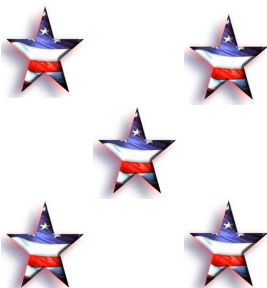
Counseling:
