After School Safety:

In order to ensure the safety of all our students and staff on campus we have some basic expectations and procedures for everyone to be aware of.

- The commons closes after school. Students getting snacks and/or beverages have until 2:50 before they need to leave.
- We lock all the exterior doors to the old building at 3:00.
- Access to the fieldhouse is limited to student athletes who are under the supervision of their coaches, or other student groups who have an advisor there to support them in decorating, planning for assemblies,
- Teachers are generally available after school (unless they are in meetings), so students are welcome to make arrangements with their teachers to get help, make up work, etc.

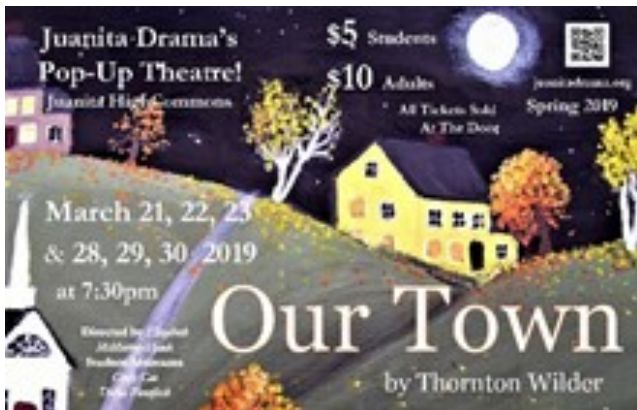
Important Information from our Nurse:

- If your student has been approved to **self-carry a life-saving medication** (EpiPen or Inhaler) please make sure they have it with them when coming to school. We had a close call recently when a student did not have the EpiPen with them when it was needed. Thankfully, the student is fine.
- If we have a confirmed case of **measles** at JHS, any students unvaccinated for measles will be sent home, for up to 2 weeks. [Please click here for a letter from the district](#) regarding this important information.
- New families have 30 days to turn in their student's **immunization records**. After that, they are considered out of compliance. Please see WA State Law RCW 28.A.210.080

There will be a 3 day window for late AP registration.

Students will be able to register for AP tests March 11-13 until 8:00am on March 13. The cost will be \$106 (\$96 for the test plus \$10 late fee). After 8:00am on March 13 we will not be able to add any more tests. If you have any questions, please ask your AP teacher or counseling. Late registration is in person only with Ms. Grager.
