



After School Safety:

In order to ensure the safety of all our students and staff on campus we have some basic expectations and procedures for everyone to be aware of.

- The commons closes after school. Students getting snacks and/or beverages have until 2:50pm before they need to leave.
- We lock all the exterior doors to the old building at 3:00pm.
- Access to the fieldhouse is limited to student athletes who are under the supervision of their coaches, or other student groups who have an advisor there to support them in decorating, planning for assemblies,
- Teachers are generally available after school (unless they are in meetings), so students are welcome to make arrangements with their teachers to get help, make up work, etc.

Important Information from our Nurse:

- If your student has been approved to **self-carry a life-saving medication** (EpiPen or Inhaler) please make sure they have it with them when coming to school. We had a close call recently when a student did not have the EpiPen with them when it was needed. Thankfully, the student is fine.
- If we have a confirmed case of **measles** at JHS, any students unvaccinated for measles will be sent home, for up to 2 weeks. This includes students with ANY type of exemption. [Please click here for a letter from the district](#) regarding this important information.
- **New families have 30 days to submit their students immunization records.** WA State law requires that all students attending school must be in compliance with immunizations. See RCW 28.A.210.080. Any new student who is out of compliance after the 30 days OR any existing student who is out of compliance will be excluded from school and sent home until they are in compliance. To be in compliance the student must have received all the required immunizations OR have a Certificate of Exemption signed by parent and Licensed Care Provider.
