- Parking Passes Required Starting Monday, Sept. 16th. Beginning on Monday, Sept. 16th, students will only be able to park on campus if they have a 2019-20 Student Parking Pass and are parking in their assigned space with their pass clearly displayed. Students may not park in the staff parking lot (the new lot), the gravel parking lot, or visitors spaces. Cars without passes or not parked in their assigned spaces will be ticketed and repeated violations may lead to the car being towed.
- Payments for class/course fees may be made starting Wednesday, September 11th, either online with a debit/credit card or with cash/check at the Bookkeeper's office.
- PE Uniforms (shirts) are \$15 and available now, either online or at the Bookkeeper's office. The Bookkeeper can only accept cash or check. .
