### PROPOSITION 1

Replacement  
Educational Programs &  
Operations (EP&O) Levy



#### STAFF, PROGRAMS, OPERATIONS and COURSE OFFERINGS

- Special Education, Highly Capable and English Learner program staff
- Substitutes, nurses, campus security, transportation and health room staff
- Athletics and extracurricular activities
- Head Start, Ready Start and Special Education preschool
- New Teacher Support Program
- Professional Learning for teachers and staff
- Seven period day for high school

*Replaces an expiring levy with a tax rate decrease.*

### PROPOSITION 2

Replacement  
Capital Projects Levy



#### FACILITY NEEDS

- Safety Measures
- Heating/ventilation systems
- Roofing replacement
- Athletic and playfield improvements
- Portables



#### TECHNOLOGY NEEDS

- Student and staff computers
- Security cameras
- Instructional software
- Network security
- Infrastructure
- Staff training
- Communication and business systems

*Replaces an expiring levy with no tax rate increase.*

### PROPOSITION 3

Bond to Reduce Overcrowding  
and Enhance Student Learning  
Environments



#### REMODEL/REBUILD and ENLARGE

- Kamiakin Middle School
- Alcott Elementary

#### ADD SCHOOLS

- New elementary school (Lake Washington Learning Community)
- New choice high school in Sammamish

#### OTHER PROJECTS

- Addition at Lake Washington High School
- Land for future projects

*The new bond will not increase the tax rate for LWSD.*



### Reduces the overall LWSD tax rate:

The total tax rate for all three measures will be reduced from the current amount of \$3.16/\$1,000 of assessed value to \$2.93/\$1,000 of assessed value.
