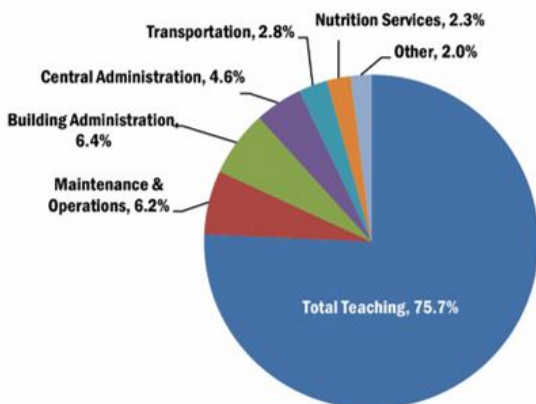
School Description

2016-17 School Goals

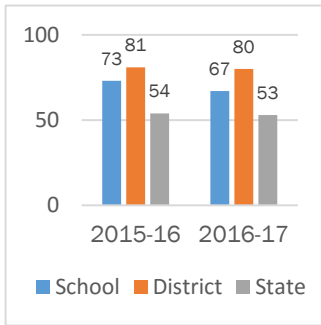
Staff used data to determine the number of students who were at standard at the beginning of the year. For those students not at standard, staff reviewed last year's data and gave diagnostic assessments. Each team calculated goals based on the data.

- K-2 Reading: 81.7% at standard on DIBELS
- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts: 74% at standard
- Grades 3-5 Math: 68.67% at standard
- Grade 5 science: 72% at standard
- Achievement gap: Reduce ELL student scoring at level 1 on SBA-Math to 20%
- School Effectiveness: Increase of staff reporting they agree for characteristic, "High Levels of Collaboration and Communication"
- Attendance: Maintain average daily attendance above 92%
- Discipline: Continue the implementation process for "Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports" schoolwide to optimize learning time

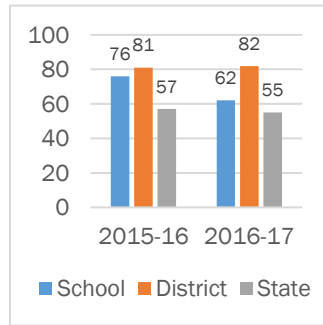

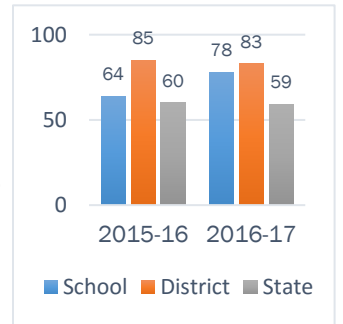
3rd Grade English Language Arts



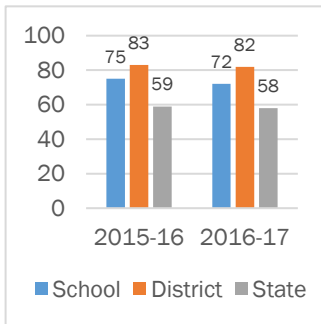
4th Grade English Language Arts



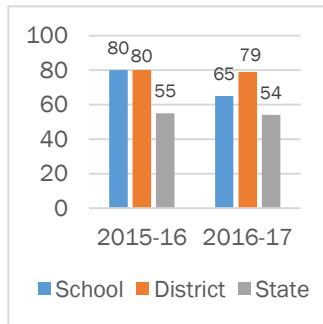
5th Grade English Language Arts



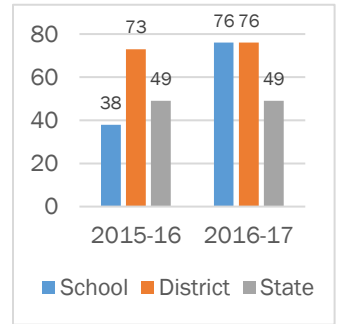
3rd Grade Math



4th Grade Math

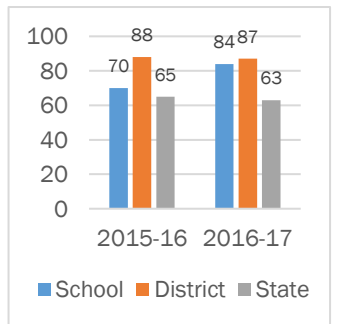


5th Grade Math



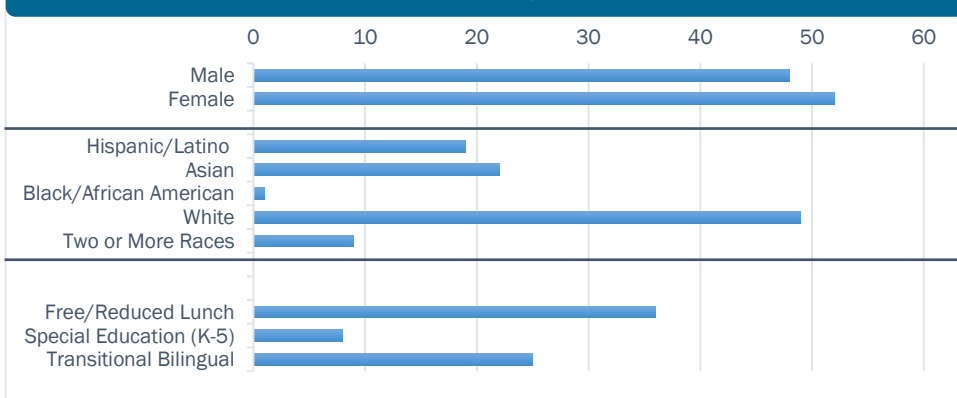
