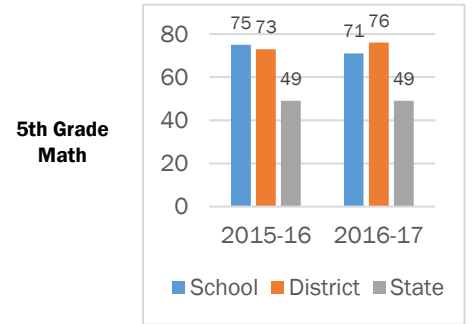
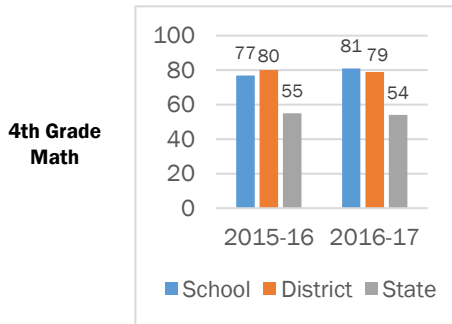
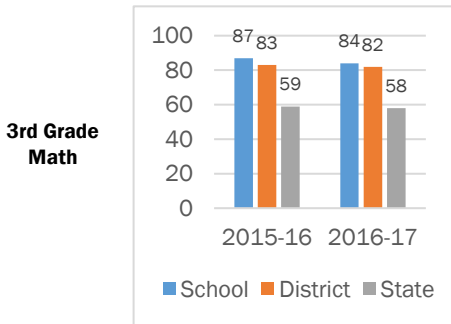
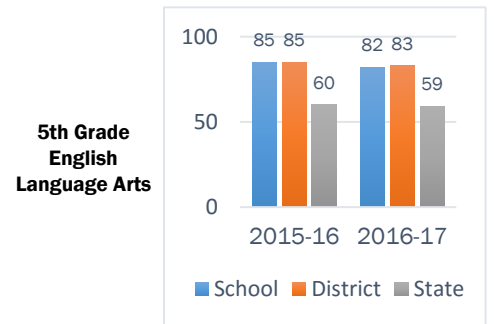
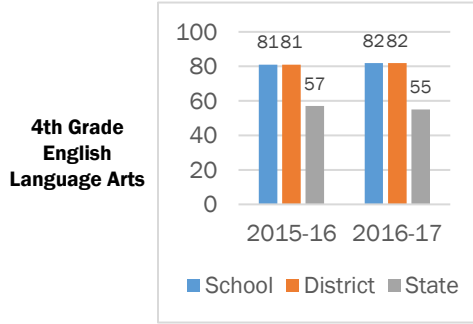
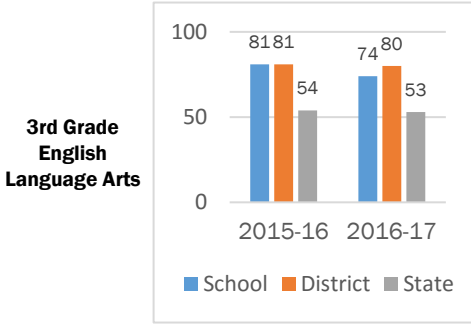
2016-17 School Goals

Teachers analyzed data for each academic area. They looked at state testing data and DIBELS scores over the past three years, whenever possible, to see the historic trends for each student. Based on this data, as well as classroom-based assessments, teachers set goals.

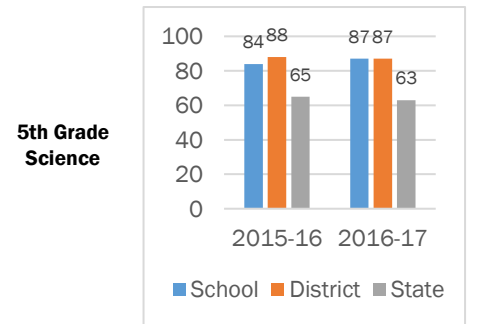
- Grades K-2 Reading: 87% at standard on end of year DIBELS
- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts: 84.5% at standard
- Grades 3-5 Math: 88% at standard
- Grade 5 science: 87% at standard
- Achievement gap: 47% of ELL students will move from progressing to proficient on the 2017 ELPA21
- School Effectiveness: Increase the weighted score to 3.25 on the staff agreement level with the statement "Student discipline is managed well." and to 3.5 with the statement, "Teachers provide feedback to each other to help improve instruction."
- Attendance: No students will be chronically absent over the course of the year
- Discipline: Decrease the number of office referrals by 10%

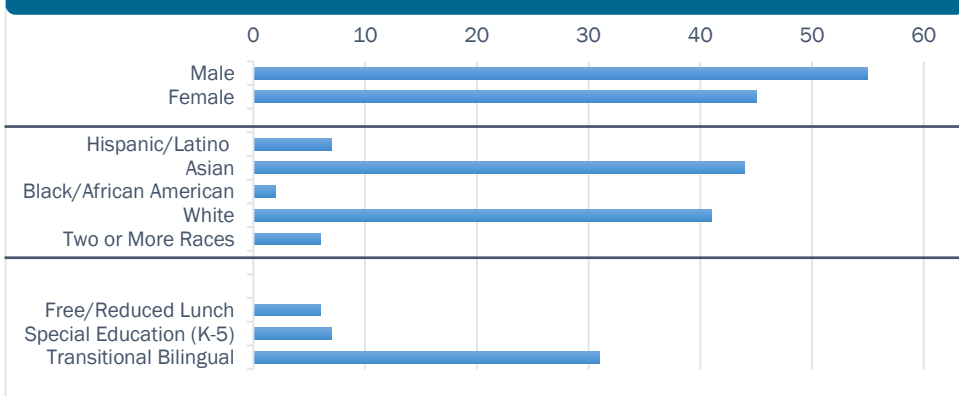


Measurements of Student Progress (MSP)
