The rich, classical learning environment is based on historical themes. We emphasize on mastery learning for all students. By integrating as many subjects as possible into year-long historical themes, students learn from the past to make better choices and decisions in the future. That enhances opportunities for integration of subject matter, increases continuity and the students' sense of belonging during early adolescence.

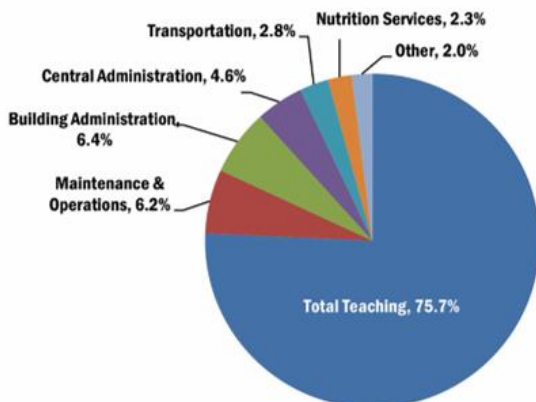

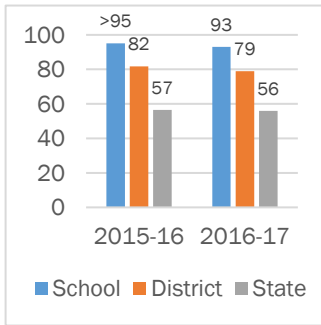
Where does the money go?



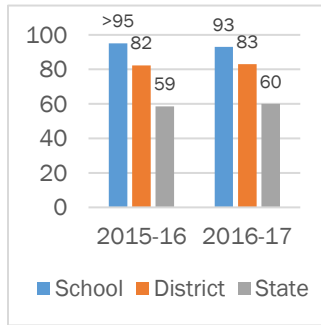

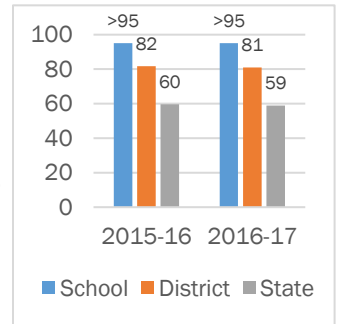
6th Grade English Language Arts



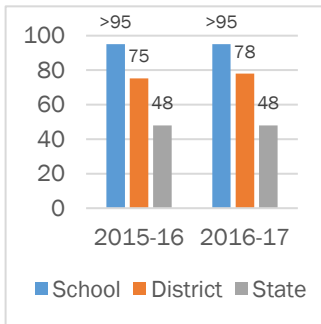
7th Grade English Language Arts



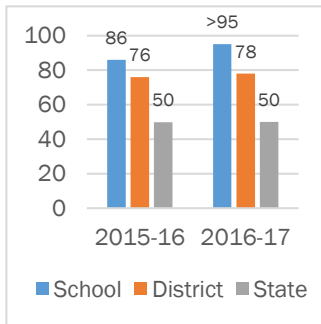
8th Grade English Language Arts



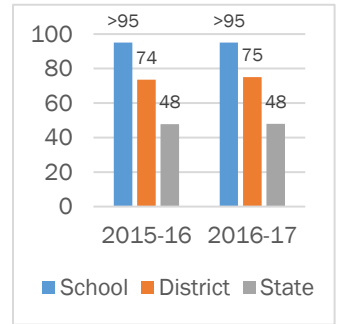
6th Grade Math



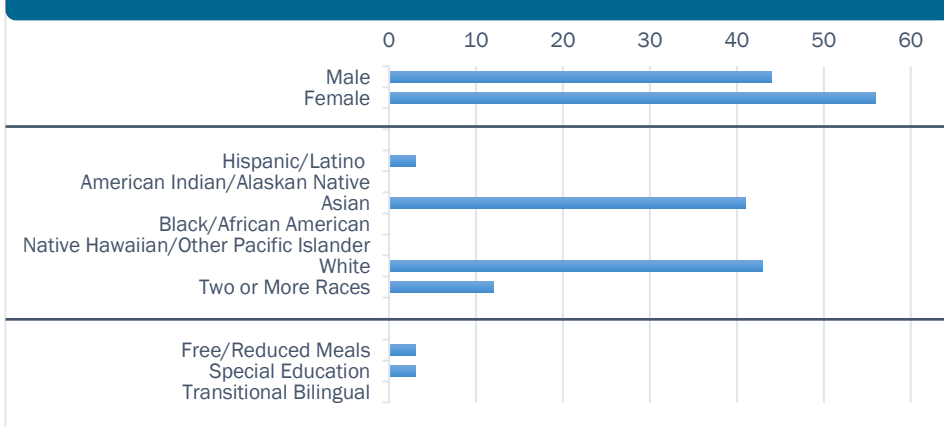
7th Grade Math



8th Grade Math

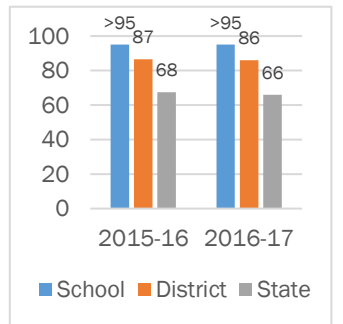


Student Demographics
