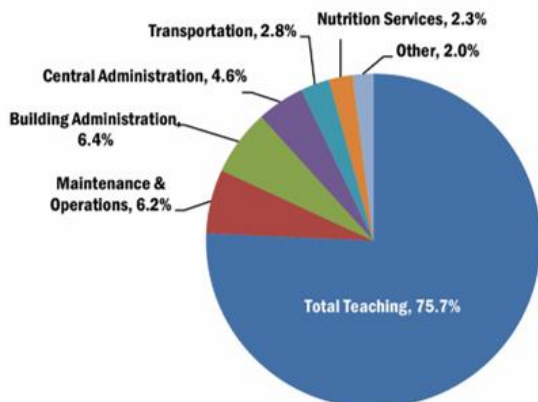
## School Description

*Where does the money go?*



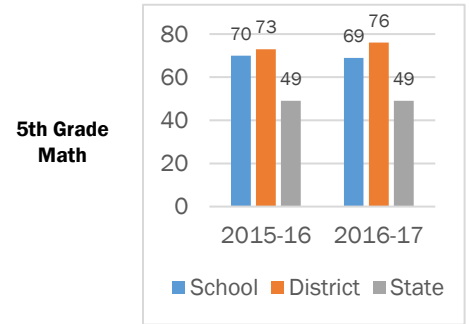
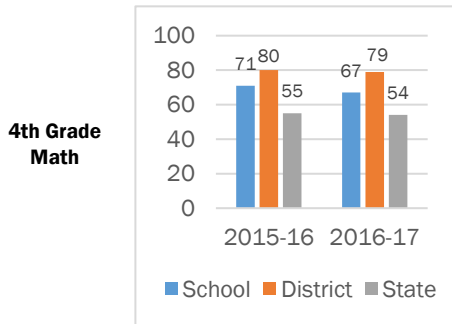
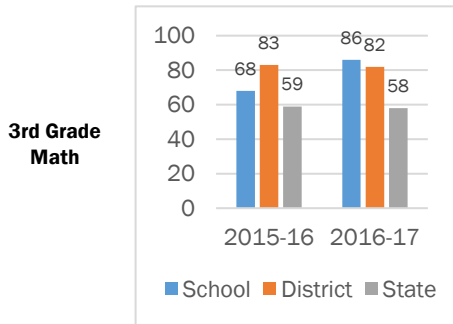
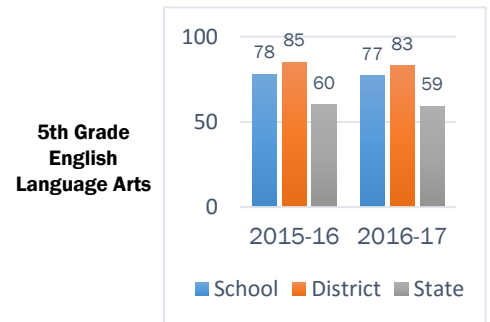
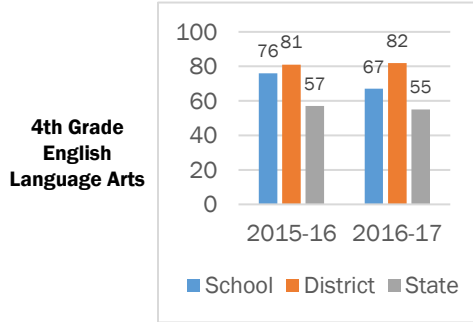
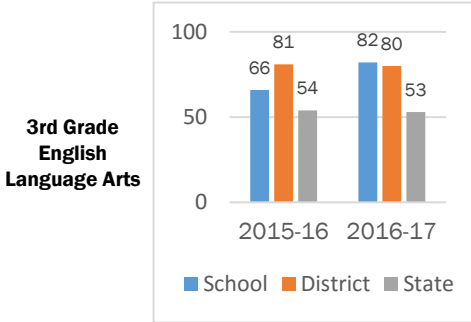
## 2016-17 School Goals

The Mark Twain staff is committed to continued student growth. Collaborative conversations among staff members have helped teams reflect on learning standards and student needs.

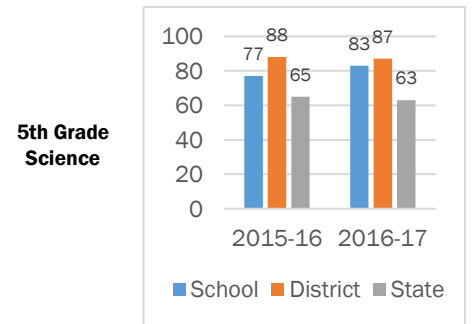
- Grades K-2 Reading: 84% of students at standard on the end of year DIBELS
- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts: 75% at standard
- Grades 3-5 Math: 77% at standard
- Grade 5 Science: 80% at standard
- Achievement gap: 30% of ELL students should reach English proficiency by the end of the year
- School Effectiveness: Increase the percentage of staff who agree with this statement: "Staff members will connect with each other outside of grade level teams" to 80%
- Attendance: 97% monthly attendance rate for each grade
- Discipline: Reduce office referrals by 10%

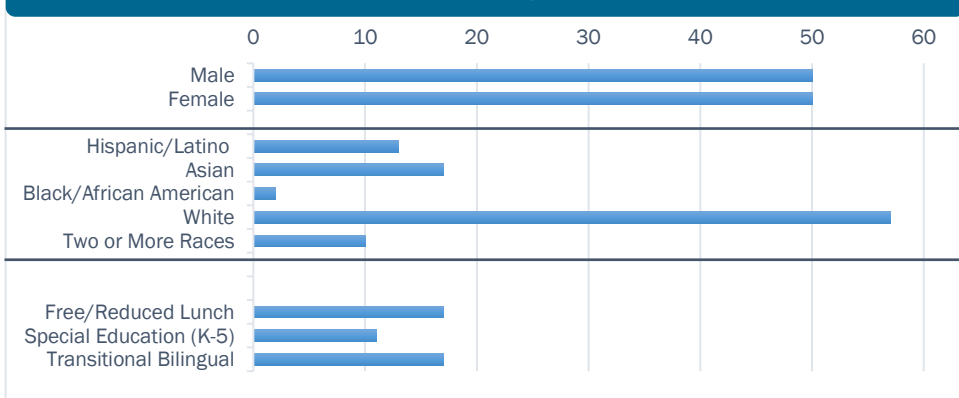
