Topic: Executive Limitations – Reasonable Interpretation

Background

Lake Washington School District’s Board of Directors operates within a framework of policy governance, which involves monitoring both Board and organizational performance. The Board monitors its own performance on an ongoing basis and annually, through Governance Process and Board/CEO Relationship policy monitoring, and a process of self-assessment, analysis, and goal setting. Throughout the year, the Board monitors organizational and CEO performance through End Results and Executive Limitations policy monitoring.

Study Session Overview

This study session will provide the opportunity for the Board to focus on Executive Limitation policy monitoring, specifically with respect to reasonable interpretation.

Study Session Key Questions

- How can Executive Limitations policies, reports and monitoring processes be improved in the same manner in which End Results policies, reports and monitoring processes have been improved?
- What process and time is needed for the Board, superintendent and team to develop and agree upon modifications to Executive Limitation policies, reports and monitoring processes?
- How will the Board plan for and implement Community Linkages in 2018-19?
