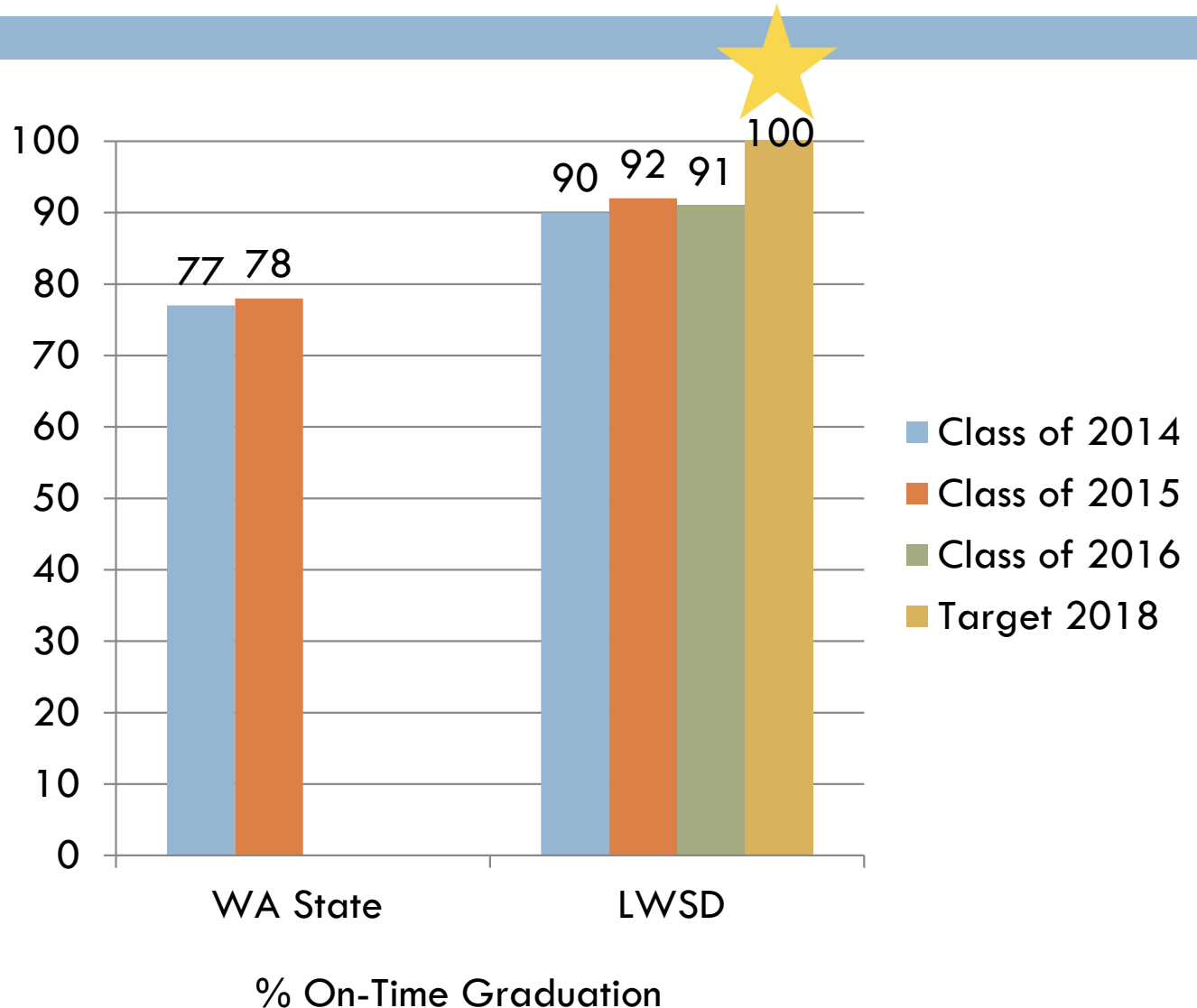
Class of 2016

- *Potential 95.4%* extended graduation rate

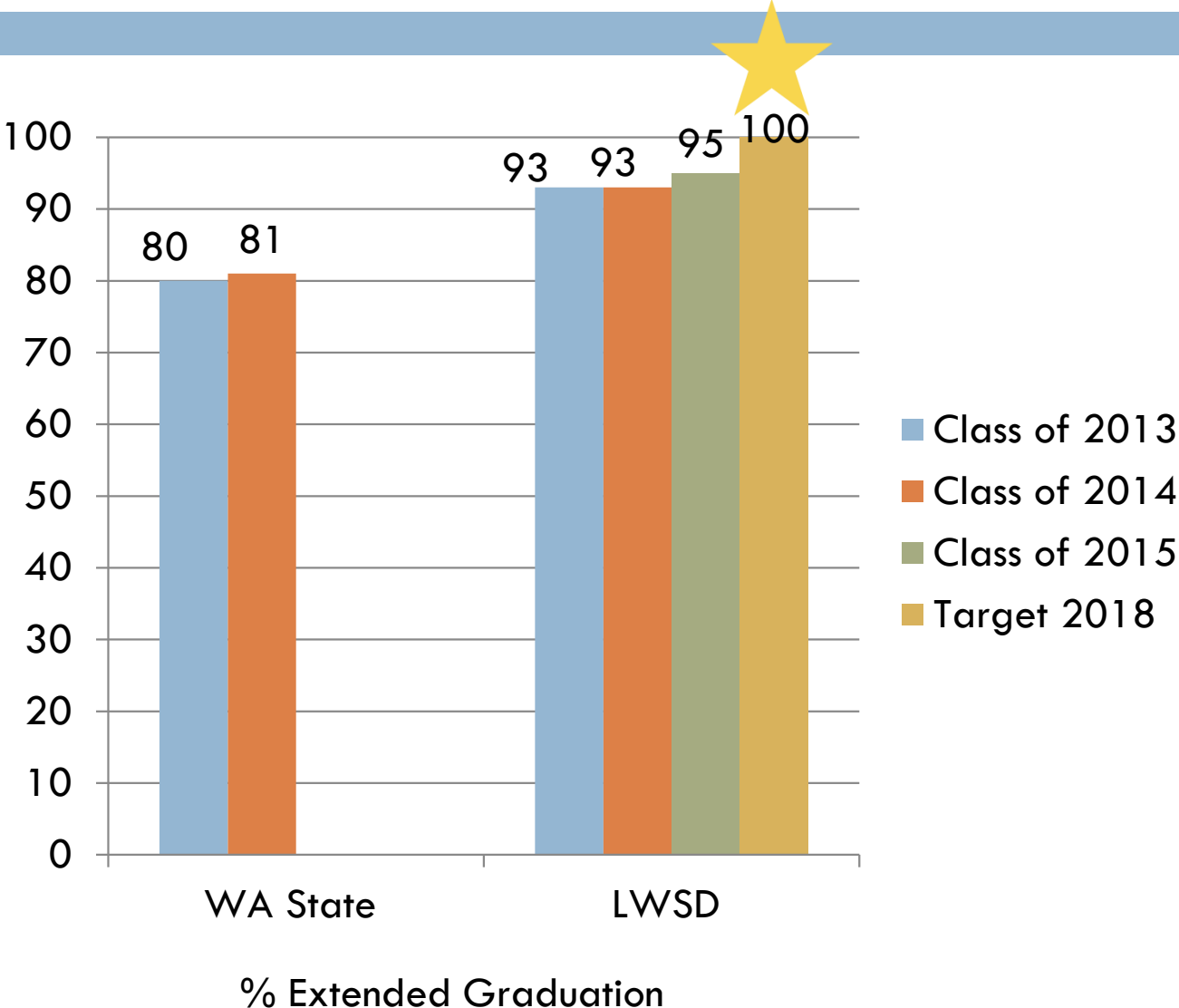
On-Time Graduation Rates

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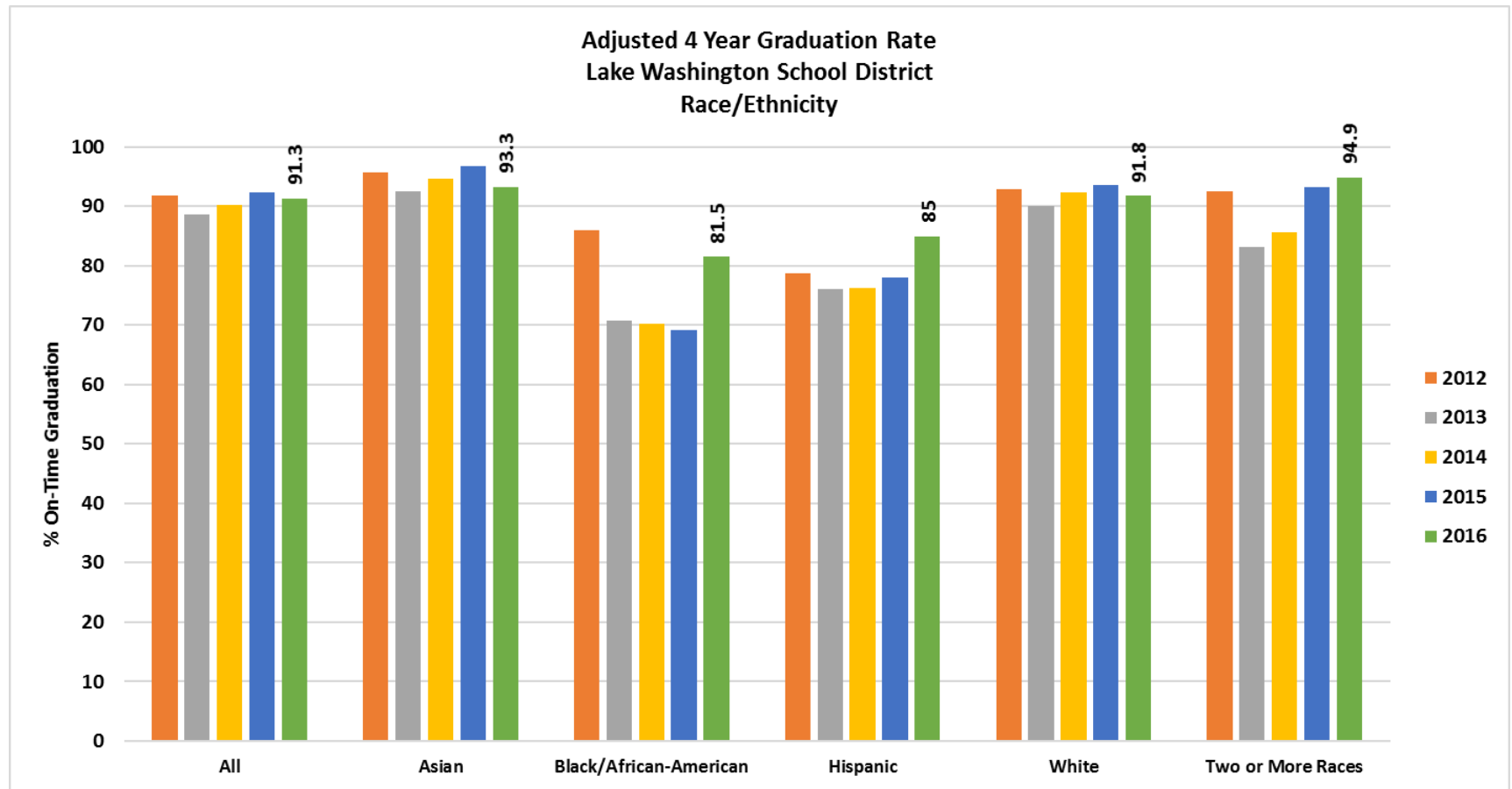


Extended Graduation Rates

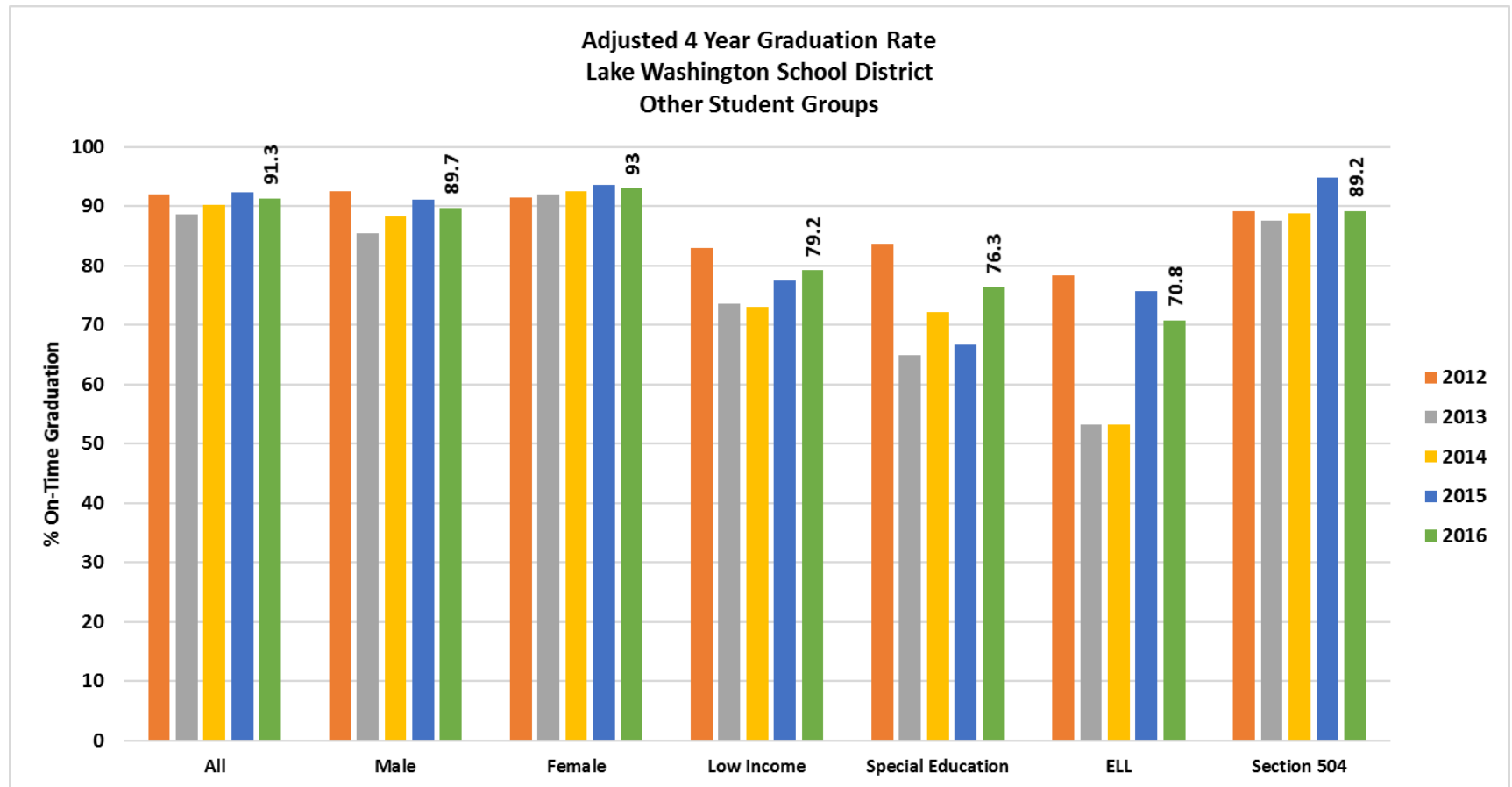
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Student Data by Race/Ethnicity
