- An interest in keeping the start and dismissal times close to what they are currently (43)

**Staff**

- An interest in an early start for elementary students (45)
- An interest in a later start time for high school students (41)
- An interest in start and dismissal times that support a reasonable commute time and family schedule for staff (30)
- An interest in keeping the start and dismissal times close to what they are currently (27)
- An interest in a high school dismissal time that permits students to participate in after-school activities (16)
