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## Civics

1. Understands that governments are organized into local, state, tribal and national levels.
2. Understands how and why state and tribal governments make, interpret, and carry out policies, rules, and laws.

## Economics

3. Understands and analyzes the costs and benefits of people's decisions to move and relocate to meet their needs and wants.
4. Understands the basic elements of Washington State's economic system, including agriculture, businesses, industry, natural resources, and labor.

## Geography

5. Constructs and uses maps to explain the movement of people.

6. Understands and creates timelines to show how historical events are organized into time periods, and eras.
7. Understands that there are multiple perspectives regarding the interpretations of historical events and creates an historical account using multiple sources.
